Army War College hosts participants in Strategy  
Implementation Seminar

CARLISLE BARRACKS, Pa. - Kansas 66th District Representative Sydney Carlin participated in the Strategy Implementation Seminar hosted by the U.S. Army War College at Carlisle Barracks, Pa., July 24-26.

Army War College students were joined in seminar by guests from those organizations that influence the implementation of national security strategy.

Rep. Carlin was among selected representatives of government, media, nongovernmental organizations, and international organizations who attended expert lectures by current military and civilian leadership, participated in seminar discussions, and developed a better understanding of the interaction of the military, diplomatic, economic and informational elements of national power.

The seminar is the capstone event of the Army War College's final resident course for the Distance Education Program. On July 27, the student body of 285 military officers of the U.S. Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Coast Guard, 11 senior federal civilians and eight foreign military officers completed two years of internet-based studies, punctuated by two two-week resident phases.

The U.S. Army War College educates the future senior leaders of the Army, and the joint, interagency, intergovernmental, and multinational communities. Its guiding principle since establishment in 1901 has been, "not to promote war, but to preserve peace." The War College education focuses students on how to think, rather than what to think, as it addresses strategic leadership;

war, national security policy and strategy; joint processes and land power development; implementing national military strategy and regional strategic studies.

The college offers its curriculum concurrently in a 10-month resident education program and a two-year distance education program.
